

## Invitation

The INTERREG BSR project “Sustainable Urban Mobility and Commuting in Baltic Cities” SUMBA invites urban transport practitioners to the [Conference on transport modelling and data management](#) which will take place December 4-5 2018 in Tallinn.

The two-day conference will be filled with topics related to data-based transport management, transport modelling with special focus on practical implementation of different tools and techniques towards more sustainable urban transport and commuting.

### **In the program You will find trending topics among transport practitioners and experts:**

#### **4<sup>th</sup> December 2018**

**First day will focus on data collection and modeling.** From new methods of gathering data and coping with issues such as fragmentation, aggregation not to mention data protection issues. We will also have a look at transport models applied in various scales from city boroughs to agglomerations including innovative solutions as illustrated by practical examples. Transport systems analytics and open source modeling tools will be the focus of the last session.

**A poster session** will present the most interesting cases and approaches to modeling the transport systems.

The day will be closed with a **joint dinner** and an opportunity for networking organized by the INTERREG BSR project SUMBA.

#### **5<sup>th</sup> December 2018**

The second day will focus on **practical solutions of the urban transport system fostering intramodality and green modes of transport.** We will look at cycling related data collection and modeling issues and aim to show practical examples of solving the first and last mile issues by combining urban transport and cycling. Simulation of bike traffic as well as innovative solutions to data collection will be presented.

**A panel discussion with top experts in the field** will highlight the importance of holistic approach to transport systems aiming at seamless intermodal solutions.
